DESCRIPTION OF INGREDIENTS


YLANG YLANG OIL is the essential oil steam-distilled from *Cananga odorata*, a plant native to the Reunion and Madagascar islands. Its aroma is described as floral, sweet, exotic and extremely fragrant.



Main active constituents of **YLANG YLANG OIL** are linalool, α-farnesene, pinene p-cresyl methyl ether and other sesquiterpenes.

In Indonesia, **YLANG YLANG** petals are strewn upon the bed on wedding nights because it is believed to have aphrodisiac qualities. Aromatherapists use **YLANG YLANG's OIL** energizing aroma to combat depression, it also helps fighting anxiety and tension while the aphrodisiac qualities are useful for impotence and frigidity. It is also useful calming rapid breathing and it can help reducing high blood pressure¹.

On the skin, **YLANG YLANG ESSENTIAL OIL** has a soothing effect and by balancing the secretion of sebum helps with over-dry as well as over-oily skin. Other property is the stimulating effect on the scalp which promotes hair growth.

APPLICATION
